I. Meet scheduling

First priority will still be given to clubs hosting meets in confirmed outside facilities. Dates will be added to the USAG Utah website once Courtney receives the email and Heather Carmody (NAWGJ SJD) receives the “Request for Judges Form” with payment. We are hoping for a smooth transition and are asking for everyone’s assistance with both meet dates and judges availability as there are limited resources available if we have multiple overlaps. III. Fall Culmination Meet

IV. Judges Carpool/Riders Fees

Effective July 2015, NAWGJ can no longer assign required carpools with meet assignments and are to refer to R&P regarding mileage reimbursement. R&P specifically states that no riders fees are to be paid. Judges may choose to ride together but are not required to do so. This could mean that you could have up to 8 drivers depending on your meet location. For Meet Directors hosting meets in the North/South parts of the State, you have the option to set up your own driver reimbursement or riders fee with NAWGJ when you submit your meet/judges request form but the USAG Utah Board & NAWGJ will not be involved in an individual request.
